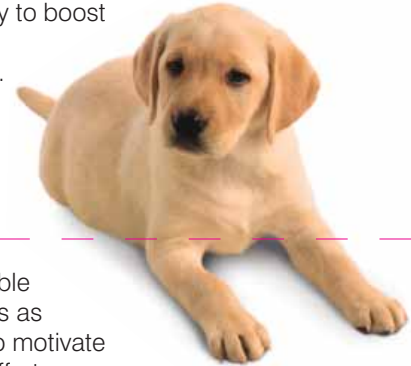
WORKPLACE GIVING

Workplace Giving is a payroll deduction program where employees can give out of their pre tax pay and gain an immediate tax benefit. You can set this up internally, which means your Payroll Department would be responsible for processing the deductions. Or there are a number of Charity Funds who specialise in setting up and administering Workplace Giving programs, who you may prefer to structure your program.

Your organisation may even choose to match dollar for dollar the funds that your staff donate through Workplace Giving, boosting the funds donated and helping their dollar to go even further.
